He served in the Ghana Foreign Service in Bonn, with UNCTAD in Geneva and the IAEA in Vienna, and spent over a decade as a Director at the World Bank's International Development Association in Washington, D.C. He is Group Chief Executive of Intercontinental Mining and Contracting Services and Fire Technik in Ghana, and a member of the Bretton Woods Committee.
